



Before the court is Plaintiffs' Motion for Leave to File a Second Amended Complaint (Doc. No. 212). Defendants filed notices indicating they do not oppose the motion. (Doc. Nos. 215 & 216.) Therefore, pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 15(a)(2), which provides that leave to amend should be "freely give[n] . . . when justice so requires," the court GRANTS the motion. Plaintiffs shall file the Second Amended Complaint in the form found at Doc. No. 212-1 by February 19, 2021.
