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Proposed Intervenors, through counsel, move for an extension of time to file a reply memorandum in support of their Motion to Intervene, and state the following in support:

1. On May 11, 2021, Proposed Intervenors filed their Motion to Intervene. (Dkt. 242)
2. Proposed Intervenors filed a motion for leave to file an overlength memorandum (Dkt. 252), which was granted on May 24, 2021. (Dkt. 253)
3. Thereafter, the parties agreed to give the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) an extension of time to file an opposition memorandum. (Dkt. 254)

4. The court granted the parties' stipulated motion, making the FTC's opposition memorandum due June 7, 2021. (Dkt. 255)

5. Proposed Intervenors' reply memorandum is due June 21, 2021. Proposed Intervenors seek a one-week extension of time, to June 28, 2021 to file a reply memorandum.

6. Counsel for Proposed Intervenors have been occupied on other deadlines and matters such that additional time is necessary to grant Proposed Intervenors' sufficient time to reply to the FTC's arguments.

7. Granting the requested relief will not prejudice the FTC, or any other party. For example, the FTC is in the midst of litigating motions for summary judgment (Dkts. 245, 257, 259), and a motion to modify the preliminary injunction order (Dkt. 244). Allowing a one-week extension for a reply memorandum in support of the Motion to Intervene will not interfere with the litigation schedule, or any upcoming hearings.

8. For the foregoing reasons, Proposed Intervenors respectfully request a one-week extension of time to June 28, 2021, to file their reply memorandum. A proposed order is submitted with this motion.
