

Broadbent, as Receiver for Defendants Zurixx, LLC and related entities, filed his Eighth Application for Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses for the Receiver and Retained Professionals, (Doc. No. 378), on August 12, 2022. No opposition was filed. Upon review of the application and attachments, and considering the lack of opposition or objection, the requested fees and expenses appear reasonable. Accordingly, the court ORDERS as follows:

2. The Receiver is authorized to pay the amounts incurred as outlined in the motion from the assets in his possession or control as Receiver of the Receivership Entities.<sup>1</sup>
